Tasting Notes

“The 1998 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of fruit from several Napa Valley vineyards including Spring Mountain and Atlas Peak. A high proportion of mountain vineyard fruit contributes to the intensely rich flavors and aromas that are evident in our 1998 Cabernet Sauvignon. Hints of nutmeg, allspice and dried currants prepare you for a mouthful of dark blackberry fruit with toasty vanilla oak. This wine is full-bodied, well balanced and has a long, lingering finish. Accessible now, expect this wine to become more complex with age.”
