



2006 Rosa Lee Sauvignon Blanc Napa Valley

Tasting Notes:

Wow! It seems like we were just walking through the vineyard to decide when to harvest the grapes for this wine and here it is in the bottle with glass slipper and all. No corkscrew required. Under the tear top foil is a beautiful glass enclosure (glass slipper) making it easier than ever to enjoy a glass of ZD Rosa Lee Sauvignon Blanc. The fruit for this wine was hand harvested from Milliken Creek Vineyard, nestled into the southern part of the Napa Valley. We fermented the juice cold and then filtered to prevent malo-lactic fermentation. The resulting wine is well balanced with a clean crisp finish. This delicious, quaffable Sauvignon Blanc paired with a chaise lounge, a few oysters and maybe a novel seems appropriately relaxing. To add a touch of sustainability, I am now using the first bottle to hold my kitchen olive oil. Please let us know your thoughts about the wine, glass slipper or just relaxing!
