



2007 Rosa Lee Petit Sirah, *Napa Valley*

Tasting Notes

Harvested from the Jonquil Vineyard (named after the fragrant narcissus flower!) located in the hills on the north east border of the Napa Valley, this 2007 Petit Sirah continues our quest to bring new, different and exciting wines to our Rosa Lee program. This 2007 Petit Sirah is dark plum purple in color, with young, bright ripe blackberry and cherry aromas, with a subtle hint of earthiness and sweet vanilla. Young "grippy" tannins envelop the core of focused black fruit on the palate. The wine has great complexity and depth and an amazingly long fruit forward finish!! Only 500 cases were produced. Enjoy!
